

Marc's Cowl

This will probably be one of the easiest projects you'll make and you'll get to stash bust to boot. Inspired by a Marc by Marc Jacobs cowl, it's basically a scarf, but without all that never ending length that's usually attached to it. A little ribbing, a little knitting, and you'll be done before you know it.

Finished Measurements

Length: 25"

Width: 7.5"

Yarn

Laines du Nord Korall (100% superwash merino, 64 yards/1.75 oz); 3 skeins, wine (you'll barely use the third skein)

Needles

6mm straights or circs

Notions

4 Buttons

Tapestry needle

Crochet hook

Gauge

16 sts/ 20 rows = 4" with 6 mm needles

Cowl

Using 6 mm needles, CO 30 and begin working K2P2 ribbing, ending with a K2. Continue for 7"

Begin working Stst for 11"

Change back to K2P2 ribbing, as before, for another 7".

BO.

Weave in ends.

Sew buttons on every other purl section, about an inch up from edge.

On opposite end chain four loops. The size of your loop depends on your buttons, I began my chain on the second knit st from the top and connected it to the first knit stitch of the next section 7 or 8 chains later.

Wear and enjoy!
